CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

GEHRING,GREG E., D.D.S. (30015433) – MADISON

Dr. Gehring's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of fourteen (14) days, effective March 1, 2005. Dr. Gehring shall complete three hours of continuing education in dental ethics within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Dr. Gehring shall complete two (2) hours of interactive continuing education in substance abuse within fourteen (14) days of the effective date of this agreement. Dr. Gehring shall take and successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence examination within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Dr. Gehring shall be subject to a probationary term of six (6) years following the effective date of this consent agreement. The effective date is March 9, 2005.

GROSSER, I. SCOTT, D.D.S. (30015651) – East Liverpool

Dr. Grosser's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of sixty (60) days beginning May 1, 2005 through May 30, 2005 and June 15, 2005 through July 14, 2005. In order to be reinstated Dr. Grosser shall meet the following terms: Dr. Grosser shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam administered by the board within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this consent agreement. Dr. Grosser shall complete twenty-five (25) hours of continuing education in Ethics. Dr. Grosser shall complete ten (10) hours of continuing education in dental infection control. Dr. Grosser must submit documentation satisfactory to the Secretary of the BOARD indicating that he is in compliance with infection control provisions. Dr. Grosser shall submit a written request to the

Secretary of the Board for reinstatement. Dr. Grosser's license to practice dentistry shall be subject to the following probationary terms and conditions for a period of three (3) years: a) Dr. Grosser shall fully cooperate in the board's inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office; b) Dr. Grosser shall obey all federal, state, and local laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio; c) Dr. Grosser shall submit to the Board, on a quarterly basis, documentation from an independent testing agency that is satisfactory to the Board demonstrating that the heat sterilizing devices in his office are tested for proper function on a weekly basis by means of a biological monitoring system that indicates microorganism kill and that immediate remedial action was taken if any biological spore test was positive. Dr. Grosser shall submit quarterly declarations to the Board stating whether or not he is in compliance with the provisions of this consent agreement. The effective date is March 9, 2005.

HARRIS, ROGER J., D.D.S. (30013286) – Milford

Dr. Harris shall complete three (3) hours of continuing education in dental ethics within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Harris shall take and successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence examination within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Dr. Harris shall be subject to a probationary term of six (6) years following the effective date of this consent agreement. Dr. Harris's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms: a) Dr. Harris shall obey all federal, state, and local laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio; b) Dr. Harris shall be audited for the next three (3) bienniums and shall submit proof of the required continuing education courses upon request. The effective date is March 9, 2005.

MCGINLEY, S. JACQUALINE, R.D.H. (31003204) – Stow

Ms. McGinley shall complete three (3) hours of continuing education in dental ethics within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Ms. McGinley shall take and successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence examination within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Ms. McGinley shall be subject to a probationary term of six (6) years following the effective date of this consent agreement. Ms. McGinley's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms: a) Ms. McGinley shall obey all federal, state, and local laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio; b) Ms. McGinley shall be audited for the next three (3) bienniums and shall submit proof of the required continuing education courses upon request. The effective date is March 9,

2005.

POWERS, MICHAEL P. , D.D.S. (30018599) – Chagrin

Dr. Powers', license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. The Board shall consider reinstatement of Dr. Powers' license to practice dentistry upon a that he is physically/mentally able to return to practice. Upon reinstatement, Dr. Powers' certificate shall be subject to the following probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of five (5) years: a) Dr. Powers shall obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio; b) Dr. Powers shall submit quarterly declarations under penalty of Board disciplinary action stating whether there has been compliance with all the conditions of this consent agreement; c) Dr. Powers shall appear in person for quarterly interviews before the Board or its designated representative, or as otherwise directed by the Board. d) In the event that Dr. Powers should leave Ohio for three (3) continuous months, or reside or practice outside the State, Dr. Powers must notify the Board in writing of the dates of departure and return. Periods of time spent outside Ohio will not apply to the reduction of this period under the consent agreement, unless otherwise determined by motion of the Board in instances where the Board can be assured that probationary monitoring is otherwise being performed; e) In the event Dr. Powers is found by the Secretary of the Board to have failed to comply with any provision of this agreement, and is so notified of that deficiency in writing, such periods of noncompliance will not apply to the reduction of the probationary period under this consent agreement; f) Dr. Powers shall abstain completely from the personal use or possession of drugs, except those prescribed, dispensed or administered to him by another so authorized by law who has full knowledge of Dr. Powers' chemical dependency and the terms of this consent agreement; g) Dr. Powers shall abstain completely from the use of alcohol; h) Dr. Powers shall participate in an aftercare program approved in advance by the Board. Participation must be for a minimum of one (1) year or until successful completion of the program, whichever occurs later. Failure to comply with any terms or conditions of the aftercare program may result in an automatic suspension of Dr. Powers' license to practice dentistry; i). Dr. Powers shall maintain participation in AA or NA, approved in advance by the Board no less than three days per week, or as otherwise directed by the Board. j) Dr. Powers shall participate in a Caduceus program, approved in advance by the Board no less than one day per week. On a quarterly basis, Dr. Powers shall submit acceptable documentary

evidence of continuing compliance with this program to the Board. k) The Board reserves the right to request Dr. Powers to submit to random urine screenings for drugs and alcohol, as directed by the Board, and shall submit results of such screening to the BOARD within seven (7) days of the screening. The effective date is March 9, 2005.

SALMANS, ROBERT S. D.D.S. (30016113) – Wooster

Dr. Salmans' license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of nine (9) months, effective April 15, 2005 until January 15, 2006. In order to be reinstated following the term of suspension, Dr. Salmans shall meet the following requirements: a) Dr. Salmans shall make a written request to the Secretary of the Board for reinstatement; b) Dr. Salmans shall complete twenty (20) hours of interactive continuing education in ethics and twenty (20) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning. Dr. Salmans shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within twenty-one (21) days of the effective date of this consent agreement. Dr. Salmans' license to practice dentistry shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of three (3) years The effective date is March 9, 2005.

SOULT, MICHAEL C., D.D.S. (30013986) – Dublin

Dr. Soult shall complete three hours of continuing education in dental ethics within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Dr. Soult shall take and successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence examination within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Dr. Soult shall be subject to a probationary term of six (6) years following the effective date of this consent agreement. The effective date is March 9, 2005.

WOLFRAM, PETER G., D.D.S. (30019840) – Maumee

Dr. Wolfram's, license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. Upon reinstatement, Dr. Wolfram's certificate shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of five (5) years. If Dr. Wolfram fails to comply with the terms and conditions of this consent agreement, Dr. Wolfram may be subjected to an automatic suspension of his license to practice dentistry. Upon successful completion of probation, Dr. Wolfram's license will be fully restored. The effective date is March 9, 2005.

YOKUM, HARRY M. D.D.S. (30016513) – West Jefferson

Dr. Yokum's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended from March 1, 2005 up through and including March 9, 2005, returning to

practice on March 10, 2005. Dr. Yokum shall complete three (3) hours of continuing education in dental ethics within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement. Prior to reinstatement, Dr. Yokum shall take and successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence examination. Dr. Yokum shall be subject to a probationary term of six (6) years following the effective date of this consent agreement. The effective date is March 9, 2005.
