

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in March 2001.

1. FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS

KLENOTIC, Ronald (30014105) - Michigan

Dental license is suspended for an indefinite period of time. Board shall not consider reinstatement to practice unless and until all of the following requirements are met: make a written request for reinstatement; shall submit documentation he has completed 40 hours of continuing education; shall obtain 20 hours of continuing education in dental ethics and treatment planning; shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam. One reinstated, doctor's license shall be subject to probation terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years; for the next 3 bienniums, shall submit CE documentation by January 31st, based on the Board finding count 1 of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to be true, involving continuing education violations. Order sent March 23, 2001, effective 30 days from date of mailing.

LEDWITH, Beth (30017607) - Virginia

Dental license is suspended for an indefinite period of time. Board shall not consider reinstatement to practice unless and until all of the following requirements are met: make a written request for reinstatement; shall submit documentation he has completed 40 hours of continuing education; shall obtain 20 hours of continuing education in dental ethics and treatment planning; shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam. One reinstated, doctor's license shall be subject to probation terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years; for the next 3 bienniums, shall submit CE documentation by January 31st, based on the Board finding count 1 of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to be true, involving continuing education violations. Order sent March 23, 2001, effective 30 days from date of mailing.

NEUGER, Sanford (30010358) – South Euclid

Dental license is suspended for no less than 14 days. Board shall not consider reinstatement to practice unless and until all of the following requirements are met: Make a written request for reinstatement; shall submit documentation of compliance with infection control provisions. Once reinstated, doctor's license shall be subject to probation terms

for a period of 1 year; shall obtain 7 hours of continuing education in infection control; shall submit quarterly declarations of compliance, based on the Board finding counts 1-8 of the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to be true, involving infection control violations. Order sent March 23, 2001, effective 30 days from date of mailing.

2. CONSENT AGREEMENTS

HARVEY, Bryan R. (1626) - Columbus

Limited Resident's license suspended indefinitely until such time as reinstated by the Board; prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted from doctor to determine if doctor is physically/mentally able to return to practice. Upon reinstatement, certificate shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years. Agreement effective March 14, 2001.

MARSHALL, Edward T., Sr. (30013417) – Norton

Doctor is requesting reinstatement of his license to practice dentistry. Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall not be reinstated until the following conditions are met: submit proof of immunity to or immunization against hepatitis B; submit documentation of completion of 40 hours of continuing education; take and pass the jurisprudence exam and received written confirmation from the Board that he has successfully fulfilled the requirements set forth therein. Agreement effective March 14, 2001.

ROSENBERG, David A. (30018818) – Solon

Dental license was suspended since January 1, 2000, for failure to renew, and doctor has been practicing without a license from that date until approximately February 6, 2001, wherein he ceased practicing, doctor is requesting reinstatement of his license and has paid all the necessary fees and late fines applicable. Dental license suspended until April 1, 2001. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to the following conditions: he will be automatically audited for the next 3 biennial renewal periods.

Radiographer's request for reinstatement, effective March 14, 2001, granted by the Board, subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations established by March 2000 Consent Agreement.
