

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in April 2002.

1. CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

CARRATOLA, THOMAS (30017926) – Streetsboro

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control Rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2002.

UM, RHINA (30020669) – Cincinnati

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to provide dental care that conforms to accepted standards for the profession. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2002.

WADSWORTH, WILLIAM F. (30012361) – Mansfield

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control Rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2002.

KIRKPATRICK, JAMES E. (30019110) – Belpre

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to provide dental care that conforms to accepted standards for the profession. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2002.

JORDAN, MARTIN E. (30019465) – Cleveland

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control Rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2002.

JORDAN, JOHN T.F. (30011022) – Washington Court House

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control Rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2002.

2. FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS:

MANGIE, RONALD E. (30012507) – Boardman

Dental license has been revoked based on the Board finding the counts contained in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing to be true, involving convictions of a felony. Order sent April 22, 2002, effective 30 days from the date of mailing. Respondent has 15 days from date of mailing to file an appeal.

2. CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

CHEEK, JOHN A. (30014928) – Columbus

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if doctor is physically/mentally able to return to practice. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years.

Agreement effective April 18, 2002.

ESKAY, GERALD A. (30014757) – Youngstown

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is suspended for 21 days beginning April 27, 2002 and ending on May 17, 2002. In order to be reinstated, doctor shall make a written request to the Secretary of the Board for reinstatement, shall submit documentation that he is in compliance with the infection control provisions. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of 1 year, shall submit on a quarterly basis documentation that the heat sterilizing devices are tested for proper function on a weekly basis, shall submit quarterly declarations that he is in compliance, doctor shall complete 12 hours of continuing education in infection control within 3 months of effective date and shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within 30 days.

GEANEKOPULOS, CRIS (30010523) – Reynoldsburg

Doctor shall complete 7 hours of continuing education in infection control within 3 months of the effective date, shall take and pass jurisprudence exam within 30 days of effective date. Doctor's license shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of 1 year, shall submit on a quarterly basis documentation that the heat sterilizing devices are tested for proper function on a weekly basis.

Agreement effective April 18, 2002.

GEANEKOPULOS, GEORGE (30010589) – Reynoldsburg

Doctor shall complete 7 hours of continuing education in infection control within 3 months of the effective date, shall take and pass jurisprudence exam within 30 days of effective date. Doctor's license shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of 1 year, shall submit on a quarterly basis documentation that the heat sterilizing devices are tested for proper function on a weekly basis.

3. **REINSTATEMENT:**

LEDWITH, BETH F. (30017607) – Tappahannock, VA

Doctor's request for reinstatement granted by the Board for the sole purpose of allowing her to permanently retire her license. Doctor voluntarily, knowingly and intelligently retires from the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Effective April 18, 2002.

BUTLER, JAMES E. (30017925) - Hilliard

Doctor's request for reinstatement granted by the Board subject to probationary conditions established by April 2002 Consent Agreement. Effective April 18, 2002.
