

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in July 2002.

1. CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

CARMAN, DAVID R. (30014224) – Gallipolis

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 22, 2002.

SPEER, RANDALL M. (30014474) – Columbus

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to provide dental care that conforms to accepted standards for the profession. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 22, 2002.

CHOW, CHARLES W. (30012192) – Columbus

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 22, 2002.

VOSS, HAROLD L. (30013775) – Columbus

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 22, 2002.

RAIFFE, DAVID M. (30019625) – Lakewood

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to provide dental care that conforms to accepted standards for the profession and permitting an unlicensed operator. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 22, 2002.

2. CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

JONES, JEFFERSON W. – California

Doctor shall be granted a license to practice dentistry in the State of Ohio upon receipt of the following: documentation satisfactory to the Board evidencing his full and unrestricted licensure to practice dentistry in California and evidence of his immunity to or inoculation against the hepatitis B virus.

Agreement effective July 18, 2002.

UM, RHINA (30020669) – Cincinnati

Doctor shall immediately cease and desist from rendering endodontic treatment. Doctor shall not undertake any new cases of endodontic treatment until she has completed either 20 hours of continuing education in endodontics at an accredited dental school or 30 hours of continuing education in endodontics by an AGD provider. In addition, doctor shall complete 14 hours of continuing education in pharmacology from an accredited dental school or 20 hours in pharmacology by an AGD provider on or before November 1, 2002. Doctor may resume providing endodontic treatment on dental patients in Ohio after providing documentation of her completion of the continuing education courses and upon Board approval. At that time, the doctor's endodontic practice is restricted to endodontic treatment on teeth with single canals only. Doctor shall continue to desist from rendering endodontic treatment on multiple canal teeth, unless she successfully completes additional continuing education designated and pre-approved by the Secretary of the Board. Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be subject to the following conditions: should doctor commence endodontic treatment on single canal teeth, she shall submit final radiographs of each completed endodontic procedure to the Board each month for 9 months.

SCHUMANN, SCOTT D. (30019001) – Columbus

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if physically/mentally able to return to practice of dentistry. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years.

Agreement effective July 18, 2002.

JORDAN, JOHN T.F. (30011022) – Washington Court House

Doctor's license shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of 1 year. Doctor shall submit on a quarterly basis documentation that the heat sterilizing devices are tested for proper function on a weekly basis, doctor shall submit quarterly declarations that he is in compliance, doctor shall complete 7 hours of continuing education in infection control within 3

months of effective date of Consent Agreement, doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within 30 days of the effective date.

Agreement effective July 18, 2002.

BURLESON, JERRY W. (30015628) – Portsmouth

Doctor's license shall be suspended for a period of 8 months effective October 1, 2002 and ending May 31, 2003. Doctor shall complete 20 hours of continuing education in dental ethics and treatment planning and submit documentation no later than October 1, 2002. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam no later than October 1, 2002. Once reinstated, doctor's license shall be subject to additional probationary terms for a period of 2 years: doctor shall immediately and without prior notice make available for inspection and review by authorized Board personnel any or all of patient records, including all billing records, doctor shall on the first day of each month send all daily appointment schedules for the previous month to the Board, doctor shall send on a quarterly basis a list of all insurance plans, if any, which he was affiliated during the previous 3 months. The first shall be sent on July 1, 2003 and every 3 months thereafter.

GOTTLIEB, LEROY M. (30016750) – Columbus

Doctor's license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations: doctor shall not undertake any new cases of orthodontic treatment, involving past, present or future patients. Doctor shall immediately refer all current patients to other practitioner(s) for orthodontic treatment. Doctor may finish orthodontic treatment of those patients whose treatment will be completed by December 1, 2002. Effective December 1, 2002, doctor shall permanently desist from rendering orthodontic treatment, except that he may place space maintainers and retention appliances.
