

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in June 2002.

1. CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

ROUZAUD, ROBERT M. (30019103) – Cleveland

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control Rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 18, 2002.

COHEN, STEVEN J. (30011979) – Cleveland

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control Rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 18, 2002.

O'BRIEN, DANIEL G. (30020555) – Beavercreek

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to provide dental care that conforms to accepted standards for the profession. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 18, 2002.

DUBEL, VICTOR J. (30018499) – Dayton

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the requirements of June 2001 Consent Agreement and failure to conform to accepted standards for the profession. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 18, 2002.

GENTILE, CRAIG M. (30020686) – Lancaster

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to provide dental care that conforms to accepted standards for the profession. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 18, 2002.

GINDER, MICHAEL D. – Wilmington, DE

Doctor applied for a dental license by criteria approval. The Board determined that the state administered examination he took does not meet the requirements outlined in the ORC Section 4715.15 or the OAC Section 4715-5-03, as the examination was not administered by a regional board, as

required for licensure in Ohio under ORC Section 4715.11. Proposal to Deny License and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 18, 2002.

2. CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

WADSWORTH, WILLIAM F. (30012361) – Mansfield

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for 14 days effective July 1, 2002. In order to be reinstated, doctor shall make a written request to the Secretary of the Board for reinstatement and shall submit documentation that he is in compliance with the infection control provisions. Upon reinstatement, doctor's license shall be subject to probationary conditions for a period of 1 year: doctor shall submit on a quarterly basis documentation that the heat sterilizing devices are tested for proper function on a weekly basis, shall submit quarterly declarations that he is in compliance, shall complete 7 hours of continuing education in infection control within 3 months of the effective date of consent agreement and shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within 30 days of the effective date.

Agreement effective June 13, 2002.

PUSHKIN, YURI Y. (30020369) – Columbus

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be permanently revoked; such permanent revocation is STAYED and the doctor's license shall be suspended for a period of 4 years to commence on July 1, 2002. Doctor shall immediately begin to refer all his patients to other practitioners and shall complete this process by July 1, 2002. Doctor shall provide 2000 hours of pro bono dental services to underserved populations, to be completed prior to reinstatement of his license. Such pro bono work shall be performed in an approved not-for-profit clinic or setting and shall be calculated by chair-time hours. All pro bono hours shall be reported to the Board Secretary on a weekly basis. After completing first year of the suspension, doctor's license shall be reinstated for sole and restricted purpose of providing pro bono dental services to the underserved populations. The Board shall not consider reinstatement of license until all of the following requirements are met: doctor shall submit an application for reinstatement, doctor shall not make application until his suspension has been completed, doctor shall complete 20 hours of continuing education in dental ethics, doctor shall provide documentation that he has completed all continuing education requirements for each biennial registration period occurring during period of suspension, doctor shall take and pass jurisprudence exam, doctor shall provide documentation that he

has completed all necessary pro bono hours, doctor shall provide documentation that he has reimbursed the ODJFS for all the money he received for all unperformed services referenced in Counts 14-56 in the Notice of Opportunity for Hearing. Upon reinstatement, doctor's license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 6 years: doctor shall immediately and without prior notice make available for inspection and review any and all of his patient records, doctor shall on the first day of each month shall send all daily appointment schedules for the previous month to the Board, doctor shall send on a quarterly basis a list of all insurance plans which we was affiliated during the previous 3 months, doctor shall submit quarterly declarations stating he is in compliance and doctor shall provide a copy of this Consent Agreement to all employers or entities with which he contracts to provide dental services.

FRYER, KENNETH D. (30021551) – Westerville

License to practice dentistry shall be granted under following permanent conditions: practice will be limited to pediatric dentistry. Effective June 12, 2002.

HARDY, ROBERT B. (30021550) – Lexington, Kentucky

License to practice dentistry shall be granted under following permanent conditions: practice will be limited to orthodontics. Effective June 12, 2002.

SPROWLS, MATTHEW W. (30021552) – Franklin

License to practice dentistry shall be granted under following permanent conditions: practice will be limited to orthodontics. Effective June 12, 2002.
