## CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

MACK, LYNN E., (30015865) – Painesville

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with requirements of March 2003 Consent Agreement. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 22, 2004.

## **CONSENT AGREEMENTS:**

**KIRKUP, CHRISTOPHER T., (Lim. Res. #1934) – Columbus**

Dr. Kirkup is currently suspended indefinitely effective immediately. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if Dr. Kirkup is physically/mentally able to return to practice of dentistry. Upon reinstatement, Dr. Kirkup shall be subject to probationary terms for five (5) years. Effective date April 21, 2004.

**MASSING, BRUCE A., (30020737) – Hamilton**

Dr. Massing shall within three (3) months of the effective date of this consent agreement successfully complete forty (40) hours of continuing education in Pharmacology, including appropriate prescribing, management of chronic pain patients and drug seeking patients, and use of NSAIDS and opioids. These hours must be taken at an ADA accredited college of dentistry. These hours must be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. Dr. Massing shall not prescribe oxycontin. Dr. Massing's license shall be subject to probationary conditions for five (5) years: a) shall cooperate in Board's inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office, b) shall personally call in or write the prescription for all controlled substances for his patients. No office personnel may call in or write prescriptions for controlled substances. Effective date April 21, 2004.

## **VOLUNTARY RETIREMENTS:**

**HADLEY, ALAN G., (30011729) – Warren**

Effective upon the date of sale of dental practice or on September 1, 2004, whichever occurs first, Dr. Hadley voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently retires from the practice of dentistry, and surrenders his renewal card in connection with his dental license. Effective date April 21, 2004.
