

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in December 2002.

2. **CONSENT AGREEMENTS:**

GENTILE, CRAIG M. (30020686) – Lancaster

Doctor shall complete 250 hours of continuing education in areas of restorative dentistry including crown, bridge, amalgam and composite dentistry, endodontics, diagnosis and treatment of caries, periodontal assessment, formulation of treatment plans, use of radiographs and charting/record keeping. Such continuing education shall be taken from a dental college accredited by the ADA and shall be mostly clinical or hands-on in nature, pre-approved by the Acting Secretary of the Board. Doctor shall commence these hours within sixty (60) days of the effective date of consent agreement and shall complete within eight (8) months of the effective date. Doctor shall complete twenty (20) hours of continuing education in dental ethics within 3 months of the effective date of this consent agreement. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within 90 days of the effective date. Doctor shall immediately cease and desist from rendering endodontic treatment and shall refer all patients to other practitioners for endodontic treatment. Doctor shall not undertake any new cases of endodontic treatment, involving past, present or future patients, until he has submitted satisfactory documentation he has completed a minimum of 25 hours of continuing education from William J. Meyers, D.M.D. at the Ohio State University College of Dentistry. These 25 hours shall be included in the two hundred and fifty (250) hours reference above. After Acting Secretary of the Board has informed doctor that he may resume providing endodontic treatment, the doctor's practice is limited to endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only. Doctor's license is subject to probationary conditions for a period of 1 year following notification that he may resume providing endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only:

doctor shall submit by the seventh day of each month, documentation for each patient to whom he provided endodontic treatment during the preceding month. Doctor's license shall be subject to following probationary conditions for two (2) years: doctor shall submit by the seventh day of each month documentation for each patient to whom he provided either a crown or bridge during the previous month. After successfully performing endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only for 1 year and complying with probationary terms, the doctor may seek approval to perform endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth, subject to successful completion of such additional continuing education designated and pre-approved by the Acting Secretary of the Board. After completing additional continuing education and being notified by Board that he may resume providing endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth, doctor's license is subject to probationary conditions for 1 year: doctor shall submit by the seventh day of each month documentation for each patient to whom he provided endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth during the preceding month.
