

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in January 2003.

1. CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

VIGH, ALEXANDER J. (30010911) – Milford

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed January 21, 2003.

2. CONSENT AGREEMENTS/ADJUDICATION ORDERS:

SPEER, RANDALL M. (30014474) – Columbus

Doctor shall complete forty (40) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning and performance of baseline periodontal evaluations. Such forty (40) hours shall be taken at an ADA accredited dental college and shall be pre-approved by the Secretary of the Board. Doctor shall, within 3 months of the effective date of this Consent Agreement, submit to the Board satisfactory documentation that he has successfully completed such hours. Doctor's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of two years: doctor shall fully cooperate with the Board investigators in future inspections and evaluations. Further, upon Board request, doctor shall make any or all of his patients records available for inspection and review. At the Board's discretion, a consultant to the Board may review such records.

Agreement effective January 28, 2003.

GINDER, MICHAEL D. (not licensed) – Wilmington, DE

Doctor shall be granted a license to practice dentistry in the state of Ohio upon successfully passing the jurisprudence examination on the laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Doctor shall provide a minimum of three hundred and thirty-five (335) hours of pro bono dental services to underserved populations, to be completed within one and one-half (1 ½) years from the date that Doctor commences the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Such pro bono work shall be pre-approved by the Secretary of the Board and reported on a weekly basis.

Consent Agreement effective January 28, 2003.

BURGER, FREDERICK J. (30017007) – Willoughby Hills

Doctor's license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if physically/mentally able to return to practice of dentistry. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 5 years.

Agreement effective January 28, 2003.

DUBEL, VICTOR J. (30018499) – Dayton

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of ninety (90) days. Upon reinstatement, license shall be subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for a period of 1 year. Doctor shall submit quarterly declarations' stating whether or not there has been compliance with all of the provisions of probation. Doctor shall obtain twenty (20) hours of continuing education in infection control approved in advance by the Board Secretary. Doctor shall notify Board of completion of these hours within three (3) months of the effective date of this Order. Doctor shall appear in person before the Board for interviews as requested by the Board. Order shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing of this Order.

3. REINSTATEMENTS:

SANTUCCI, A. SCOTT (30018923) – Niles

Doctor's request for reinstatement was granted on September 11, 2002 by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by February 2001 Consent Agreement. Upon reinstatement, the Board was notified that the Doctor had not renewed his license. After completing the required forty (40) hours of continuing education required at the time of renewal, doctor requested his license now be reinstated.

Doctor's request for reinstatement was granted on January 15, 2003 by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by February 2001 Consent Agreement.

LAPP, RICHARD (30011423) – Zanesville

Doctor's request for reinstatement was granted on January 15, 2003 by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by November 2002 Consent Agreement.
