

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in January 2004.

CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

PROVINCE, SUSAN L. (30020902) – Andover

Based on the doctor's alleged conviction of a felony. Notice of Immediate Suspension & Opportunity for Hearing mailed January 9, 2004.

FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS:

HAAG, RAYMOND J. (30021620) – Marietta

Dental license is suspended for fourteen (14) days, based on the Board finding Counts 1 and 2 of the Notice of Opportunity to be true, involving failure to comply with infection control rules and failure to meet the standard of care. Once reinstated, Dr. Haag's license shall be subject to probationary terms for three (3) years. Dr. Haag shall obtain forty (40) hours of continuing education in crown and bridge and treatment planning approved in advance by the Board Secretary and shall be completed within three (3) months of the effective date of this Order. Dr. Haag shall obtain fifteen (15) hours of continuing education in dental ethics and treatment planning, approved in advance by the Board Secretary and shall be completed within six (6) months of the effective date of this Order. Dr. Haag shall submit quarterly declarations stating he is in compliance with the terms of this Order. Dr. Haag shall obey all laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Dr. Haag shall cooperate with the Board should records be requested for inspection by the Board. Order sent January 9, 2004 and will become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing this Order. Respondent has 15 days from date of mailing to file an appeal.

VIGH, ALEXANDER J. (30010911) – Milford

Dental license is REVOKED, based on the Board finding Counts 1, 2 and 3 of the Notice of Opportunity to be true, involving violation of consent agreement and practicing without a current, valid license. Order sent January 9, 2004 and is effective upon the date of mailing this Order. Respondent has 15 days from date of mailing to file an appeal.

CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

MOORHEAD, THOMAS W. (30012717) – Sciotoville

Dr. Moorhead's license shall be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, effective January 15, 2004. [Such suspension is stayed with the exception of twenty-one (21) days.] In order to be reinstated, Dr. Moorhead shall meet following requirements: a) make a written request to Secretary of the Board for reinstatement, b) submit documentation satisfactory to the Board Secretary indicating that he is in compliance with the infection control provisions, c) complete seven (7) hours of continuing education in dental infection control, pre-approved by the Board Secretary and shall submit documentation within three (3) months of the effective date of the consent agreement, and d) shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within thirty (30) days of the effective date of the consent agreement. Upon reinstatement, Dr. Moorhead shall provide a minimum of thirty (30) hours of pro bono dental services to the underserved populations, to be completed within one year from the date of reinstatement of his license. Such pro bono work shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary and the location must be pre-approved. All pro bono hours must be reported to the Board Secretary on a weekly basis. Dr. Moorhead's license shall be subject to the following probationary conditions for a period of three (3) years: a) shall fully cooperate in the Board's inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office, which shall occur as often as the Board deems necessary, b) shall submit on a quarterly basis, documentation from an independent testing agency that the heat sterilizing devices in his office are tested for proper function on a weekly basis, c) shall submit

quarterly declarations stating that he is in compliance with the terms of the consent agreement and d) shall obey all laws governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Effective date January 7, 2004.

LANGA, GEORGE A., (30013522) – Euclid

Dr. Langa shall complete sixty (60) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning, diagnosis of decay, dental radiography, record keeping, restorative dentistry and periodontal assessment, diagnosis and charting. The hours shall be taken at an ADA accredited dental college and shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary and shall be submitted by April 1, 2004. Dr. Langa's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms for three (3) years: a) shall fully cooperate with Board investigators in future inspections and evaluations and shall make patient records available for inspection and review, b) each patient shall receive appropriate radiographs in accordance with the recommendations of the ADA, such radiographs shall be properly documented in the patient's chart, c) each adult patient shall receive a baseline periodontal evaluation and charting and, at each re-call appointment, the patient shall receive a periodontal re-evaluation, with results properly documented in the patient's chart, d) shall obey all laws governing the practice of dentistry. Effective date January 7, 2004.

ROBERTSON, EDWARD N., (30017465) – Beachwood

Dr. Robertson's license is suspended for thirty (30) days, effective January 15, 2004. Dr. Robertson shall complete eighty (80) hours of continuing education, forty (40) hours in TMD diagnosis and treatment and forty (40) hours in Pharmacology and proper prescribing. These hours must be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. After completing the continuing education requirements, Dr. Robertson shall write a letter indicating how he would manage Patient #1 (as referenced in the Confidential Patient Key) were he to present today. Dr. Robertson shall not prescribe, administer or dispense any medications, which require a DEA number until Dr. Robertson completes the suspension, the continuing education and writes the letter. Dr. Robertson's

license shall be subject to the following probationary terms for one (1) year: a) shall on a monthly basis submit to the Board progress notes for all patients he treated for TMD in the previous month, b) shall fully cooperate with the Board investigators in future inspections and evaluations, c) shall obey all laws governing the practice of dentistry. Effective date January 7, 2004.

LAPP, RICHARD, (30011423) – Zanesville

Dr. Lapp's license is suspended for one (1) month, effective January 12, 2004. Dr. Lapp shall complete eighty (80) hours of continuing education in conscious sedation and general anesthesia. Such hours shall be taken at an ADA accredited dental college and shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary and shall submit documentation of completion within three (3) months of the effective date of consent agreement. Dr. Lapp will immediately, voluntarily and permanently cease providing any surgical treatment of patients for temporomandibular disorder (TMD). Dr. Lapp will immediately, voluntarily and permanently cease placing dental implants on patients. Dr. Lapp's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms for two (2) years: a) shall fully cooperate with Board investigators in future inspections and evaluations and shall make patient records available for inspection and review, b) shall obey all laws governing the practice of dentistry. Effective Date January 7, 2004.

BLAND, JOHN C., (30014822) – Warren

Dr. Bland shall complete either one-hundred (100) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning including periodontal assessment, diagnosis charting, record keeping and crown and bridge within six (6) months of the effective date or shall complete one-hundred twenty (120) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning including periodontal assessment, diagnosis and charting, record keeping and crown and bridge within eight (8) months of the effective date. These hours shall be taken at an ADA accredited dental college and shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary and documentation shall be submitted within the specified time. Dr. Bland's license shall be subject to the following probationary

terms for three (3) years: a) shall fully cooperate with Board investigators in future inspections and evaluations and shall make patient records available for inspection and review, b) shall obey all laws governing the practice of dentistry. Effective date January 7, 2004.

MARTONE, VALERIE D., (30019492) – E. Liverpool, PA

Dr. Martone shall provide two indigent patients with pro bono comprehensive orthodontic treatment. The orthodontic treatment on these patients shall commence within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this consent agreement and shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. Dr. Martone agrees that she will automatically be audited for the next three (3) biennial renewal periods. Dr. Martone agrees that she will obey all the laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Effective date February 4, 2004.

Doctor's request for reinstatement granted by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by the September 2003 Consent Agreement. Effective January 7, 2004.
