Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in July 2005.

CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

CORDRAY, FRANK E., (30017637) – Columbus

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to administer drugs/prescriptions for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purpose and failure to meet the standard of care. Notice of Automatic Suspension and Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 26, 2005.

SPERBER, HOWARD E., (30015433) – Madison

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the continuing education requirements required for renewal. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 26, 2005.

LANGA, GEORGE A., (30013522) – Euclid

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to meet the standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 26, 2005.

SIBCY, KATINA M., (30012979) – Monroe

Based on the radiographer's alleged conviction of a felony. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed April 26, 2005.

CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

CORDRAY, FRANK E., (30017637) – Columbus

Dr. Cordray's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of twenty-eight (28) days, effective September 1, 2005. Dr. Cordray shall make a written request reinstatement. Dr. Cordray shall submit documentation that indicates that he is in compliance with the infection control provisions. Dr. Cordray shall complete twenty-seven (27) hours of continuing education in dental infection control. Dr. Cordray shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam with thirty (30) days. Dr. Cordray shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years. The effective date is July 20, 2005.

WADSWORTH, WILLIAM F., D.D.S. (300123861) – MANSFIELD

Dr. Wadsworth's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of ninety (90) days effective June 1, 2005. Dr. Wadsworth shall provide a minimum of five hundred (500) pro bono dental services. The effective date is April 27, 2005.

O'BRIEN, DANIEL G., D.D.S. (30020555) – Beaver Creek

Dr. O'Brien's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of fourteen (14) days effective April 22, 2005 and ending May 5, 2005. Dr. O'Brien must complete twenty (20) hours of continuing education in endodontics and seven (7) hours of ethics. Dr. O'Brien shall take and successfully complete the Board's jurisprudence examination. Dr. O'Brien shall be subject to a probationary term of two (2) years following the execution of this consent agreement. The effective date is April 27, 2005.
