

# FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in July 2003.

## CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

BACON, R. SCOTT. (30017298) – Grafton

Based on the doctor's alleged conviction of a felony. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 11, 2003.

CRAWFORD, WILLIAM D. (30015633) – Youngstown

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 11, 2003.

MALKOFF, MAX A. (30012912) – Youngstown

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 11, 2003.

PIERCE, KEISHA – Akron

Ms. Pierce applied for a dental assistant radiographer license. The Board determined that she failed to meet the qualifications of "good moral character" as required by ORC Section 4715.53 (B)(2). Proposal to Deny License and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 10, 2003.

SAMS, ALLISON J. (31007276) – Columbus

Based on the dental hygienist's alleged failure to comply with requirements of December 2001 consent agreement. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed July 11, 2003.

## **FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS:**

**LESINSKI-LAUER, MARY C. (30017941) – University Heights**

Dr. Lesinski-Lauer's license is suspended for a period of thirty (30) days. The Board shall not consider reinstatement of her license unless the following requirements are met: Dr. Lauer-Lesinski shall make a written request to Board Secretary for reinstatement. Upon reinstatement, doctor shall be subject to probationary period for three (3) years: a) Doctor shall obtain twenty (20) hours of continuing education in dental ethics and treatment planning approved in advance by the Board Secretary. Doctor shall notify Board of completion of these hours within three (3) months of effective date of this order; b) Doctor shall obey all laws regarding dentistry; c) Doctor shall submit quarterly declarations stating whether there has been compliance with all conditions of order; d) In the event Doctor should leave Ohio for three (3) continuous months or reside or practice outside the state, doctor must notify Board in writing of departure and return; e) Upon successful completion of probation, doctor's license will be fully restored. This order shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of the mailing of this order. Adjudication Order mailed July 15, 2003.

## **CONSENT AGREEMENTS:**

**VIGH, ALEXANDER J. (30010911) – Milford**

Doctor's license shall be suspended for a period of thirty (30) days, effective July 15, 2003. In order to be reinstated, doctor shall meet the following requirements: Doctor shall make a written request to Board Secretary for reinstatement. Doctor shall personally appear before the Board to describe in detail the procedures he has implemented to ensure that his office is in compliance with Ohio Administrative Code Section 4715:20-02. Upon reinstatement, doctor's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms/conditions for period of one (1)

year: a) Doctor shall fully cooperate in Board's inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office; b) Doctor shall submit quarterly declarations to the Board stating whether there has been compliance with all terms of consent agreement; c) Doctor shall complete twenty-one (21) hours of continuing education: seven (7) hours in dental ethics and fourteen (14) hours in infection control. These hours shall be pre-approved by the Secretary of the Board. Doctor shall submit documentation of completion of these hours within three (3) months of the effective date of this agreement; d) Doctor shall taken and pass the jurisprudence exam at the Board office within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement; e) Doctor shall provide a minimum of one-hundred and twenty (120) hours of pro-bono dental services to underserved populations to be completed within four (4) months from the date of reinstatement of his license following the suspension. Such pro-bono work shall be pre-approved by the Secretary of the Board. All hours shall be reported to the Board on a weekly basis.

**HIGH, MELISSA A. (31007777) – Galloway**

Ms. High's license shall continue to be suspended until at least January 1, 2004. In order to be reinstated, Ms. High shall meet the following requirements: a) Ms. High shall submit an application for reinstatement accompanied by all applicable fees; b) Ms. High shall appear before the Board at its December 2003 Board meeting and request reinstatement of her dental hygiene license; c) The Board has received satisfactory documentation showing Ms. High has completed twenty (20) hours of continuing education in dental ethics pre-approved by the Board Secretary. Upon reinstatement, Ms. High's license shall be subject to the following probationary terms/conditions for a period of four (4) years: a) Ms. High shall personally appear before the Board at the time she files for renewal of her dental hygiene license in 2005 and 2007, and at such other times, as requested; b) Ms. High shall provide a minimum of two hundred (200) hours of pro-bono dental hygiene services to underserved

populations, to be completed within twelve (12) months from the date of reinstatement. Such pro-bono shall be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. All pro-bono hours shall be reported to the Board on a weekly basis.
