Dr. Schoonmaker's license to practice dentistry is indefinitely suspended. Dr. Schoonmaker shall submit to an evaluation by a treating practitioner within seventy-two (72) hours for drug and alcohol dependency. Dr. Schoonmaker shall provide a written report of evaluation by a treating practitioner, indicating that Dr. Schoonmaker is no longer drug or alcohol dependent and is able to practice dentistry in accordance with the accepted standards of the profession. Dr. Schoonmaker shall provide the BOARD with documentation from an approved treatment provider that he has successfully completed treatment and is in compliance with any aftercare or outpatient treatment. Dr. Schoonmaker shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in an aftercare program. Dr. Schoonmaker shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in a Caduceus program no less than one day per week. Dr. Schoonmaker shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in AA or NA no less than three days per week, or as otherwise directed by the Board.
