CONSENT AGREEMENTS

BEAN, KEVERT, D.D.S. (30010538) BOARDMAN

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of one (1) week effective April 20, 2006. Doctor shall submit an application for reinstatement accompanied by the appropriate fees. Doctor shall submit proof of his continuing education from the previous biennium. Doctor shall appear before the Board at its June 14, 2006 meeting for purposes of reinstatement interview. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence examination. Upon reinstatement doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years. Effective date June 15, 2006.

Doctor shall appear before the Board at its June 14, 2006 meeting for purposes of reinstatement interview. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence examination. Hygienist shall provide documentation from a treatment provider that she has successfully completed treatment and is in compliance with any recommended treatment. Hygienist shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in an aftercare program. Hygienist shall maintain participation in AA or NA no less than three days per week. Upon reinstatement radiographer shall be subject to a probationary term of five (5) years. Effective date June 15, 2006.

ULLMAN SEYMOUR, D.D.S. (30012357) – SHAKER HEIGHTS

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of fourteen (14) days effective July 17, 2006. Doctor shall immediately cease and desist from performing crown and bridge, and extractions. Within eighteen (18) months the doctor shall complete one hundred twenty (120) hours of continuing education Doctor shall submit a written request for reinstatement. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence examination. Upon reinstatement doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of two (2) years. Effective date June 15, 2006.
