

# FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in March 2006.

## CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS

### **BROOKE, JOHN M., D.D.S. (30015402) – Napoleon**

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with accepted standard of the profession because of physical or mental disability dependence on alcohol or other drugs, or excessive use of alcohol or other drugs. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed March 30, 2006.

### **LAUER, MARY C., D.D.S. (30017941) – University Heights**

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the terms of the Adjudication Order of July 15, 2003. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed March 30, 2006.

### **KELLY, SCOTT S., D.D.S. (30016259) – Maumee**

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with accepted standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed March 30, 2006.

## FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS

### **NATOLI, SAMUEL, D.D.S., (300111054)– Westerville**

Doctor's dental license is suspended for a period of sixty (60) days. Sixty (60) days of suspension is stayed. Doctor shall take twenty (20) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning, and twenty (20) hours of continuing education in infection control. Doctor shall submit a written request for reinstatement. Doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years. Doctor shall (A) submit quarterly declarations under penalty of Board discipline stating that he is in compliance with the terms of this Order; (B) obey all federal, state and local laws, and all rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Order

shall become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing of the Order. The Order was mailed April 4, 2006.

## **CONSENT AGREEMENTS**

### **DECKARD, DELANE, (51010634) – Newark**

Radiographer's license to practice radiography shall be suspended for a period of two (2) weeks effective March 30, 2006. Radiographer shall submit an application for reinstatement. Radiographer shall submit proof of her continuing education for the previous biennium. Radiographer shall appear before the Board at its March 29, 2006 meeting. Radiographer shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam. Radiographer shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years upon reinstatement. Effective date March 29, 2006.

### **DRAUGHON, REBECCA A., (51003493) – Columbus**

Radiographer's license to practice radiography shall be suspended for a period of two (2) weeks effective March 29, 2006. Radiographer shall submit an application for reinstatement. Radiographer shall submit proof of her continuing education for the previous biennium. Radiographer shall appear before the Board at its March 29, 2006 meeting. Radiographer shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam. Radiographer shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years upon reinstatement. Effective date March 29, 2006.

### **HALL, DIANA L., (51008496) – Maumee**

Radiographer's license to practice radiography shall be suspended for a period of two (2) weeks effective March 30, 2006. Radiographer shall submit an application for reinstatement. Radiographer shall submit proof of her continuing education for the previous biennium. Radiographer shall appear before the Board at its March 29, 2006 meeting. Radiographer shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam. Radiographer shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years upon reinstatement. Effective date March 29, 2006.

### **HERZNER, LISA M. , (51004075) – Cincinnati**

Radiographer's license to practice dental assistant radiography shall be indefinitely suspended. Radiographer shall provide to the Board a written report of evaluation by a treating practitioner indicating Radiographer is no longer drug or alcohol dependent. Radiographer shall provide

documentation from a treatment provider that she has successfully completed treatment and is in compliance with any recommended treatment. Radiographer shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in an aftercare program. Radiographer shall maintain participation in AA or NA no less than three days per week. Upon reinstatement radiographer shall be subject to a probationary term of five (5) years. Effective date March 29, 2006.

**KAISER, LAWRENCE H. III, D.D.S., (30018237) – Warren**

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be indefinitely suspended. Doctor shall provide written report of evaluation by a treating practitioner indicating that Doctor is no longer drug or alcohol dependent. Doctor shall provide documentation from an approved treatment provider that he has successfully completed treatment and is in compliance with any aftercare or outpatient treatment. Doctor shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in an aftercare program. Doctor shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in a Caduceus program. Doctor shall provide satisfactory documentation of continuous participation in AA or NA no less than three days per week. Upon reinstatement doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of five (5) year following the effective date of this consent agreement. Effective date March 29, 2006.

**MILLS, CHARLES E., D.D.S., (30020303) – Cincinnati**

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be subject to a probationary term of one (1) year. Doctor shall complete twenty (20) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning. Doctor shall complete seven (7) hours of continuing education in ethics. Effective date March 29, 2006.

**REIFENBERGER, DAVID E., D.D.S., (3005326) - LIMA**

Doctor shall not undertake any new cases of endodontic treatment. In order to resume endodontic treatment, doctor must complete a minimum of sixty (60) hours of continuing education in endodontics. Doctor shall submit documentation satisfactory to the Secretary of the Board requesting to resume endodontic treatment. Doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of one (1) year following notification that he may resume endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only. Doctor shall submit documentation for each patient who doctor has provided endodontic treatment during the preceding month. After successfully performing endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only for one year and complying with the probationary terms and conditions, doctor may seek approval to perform endodontic

treatment on posterior and multicanal teeth. Doctor shall be subject to an additional probationary term of one (1) year following notification that he may resume endodontic treatment on posterior and multiple teeth. Doctor shall submit documentation for each patient who doctor has provided endodontic treatment during the preceding month. Effective date March 29, 2006.

**SLACK, CRAIG A., D.D.S., (30018548) - COLUMBUS**

Doctor's license to practice dentistry shall be suspended for a period of fourteen (14) days effective April 10, 2006. Doctor shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam within fourteen (14) days. Doctor shall not resume orthodontic treatment until he has complete forty (40) hours of continuing education in orthodontic diagnosis, treatment planning, record keeping and selection of patients. Doctor shall submit a written request to resume providing restricted orthodontic treatment. Doctor's license shall be subject to the following additional terms. Upon reinstatement doctor shall be subject to a probationary term of three (3) years. Effective date March 29, 2006.
