Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in November 2003.

## CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

HAAG, RAYMOND J. (30021620) – Marietta

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to meet the standard of care and failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed November 7, 2003.

HALDEMAN, JAMES D. (30016146) – Columbus

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to meet the standard of care and misrepresentation. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed November 7, 2003

MOORHEAD, THOMAS W. (30012717) – Sciotoville

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to comply with the infection control rules. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed November 7, 2003.

VIGH, ALEXANDER J. (30010911) – Milford

Based on the doctor's alleged violation of consent agreement and practicing while license is under suspension. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed November 7, 2003.

## FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS:

BROWN, MARY M. (30021292) – Phoenix, Arizona

Dental license is Revoked, based on the Board finding Count 1 of the Notice of Opportunity to be true, involving felony convictions. Order sent November 7, 2003 and effective

immediately upon receipt of the Order. Respondent has 15 days from date of mailing to file an appeal.

## **CONSENT AGREEMENTS:**

**ARICK, TAMMY L. (51000018) – Dover**

Ms. Arick is currently suspended indefinitely effective immediately. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if Ms. Arick is physically/mentally able to return to practice of radiography. Upon reinstatement, Ms. Arick shall be subject to probationary terms for five (5) years: A). Ms. Arick shall submit quarterly declarations stating that she has been in compliance with consent, 2) Ms. Arick shall appear for quarterly interviews or as directed, if Ms. Arick leaves Ohio for three (3) continuous months, Ms. Arick must notify Board in writing of dates of departure and return. Ms. Arick shall abstain completely from personal use or possession of drugs, except those prescribed by another so authorized to do so. Ms. Arick shall abstain completely from use of alcohol. Ms. Arick shall participate in aftercare program approved in advance by Board and shall be a minimum of one (1) year. Ms. Arick shall maintain participation in AA or NA, approved in advance by the Board, no less than three (3) days per week. On quarterly basis, Ms. Arick shall submit documentation of continuing compliance with program. Ms. Arick shall participate in Caduceus Program, approved in advance by Board, no less than one day per week. On quarterly basis, Ms. Arick shall submit documentation of continuing compliance with program. Board reserves right to request Ms. Arick to submit random urine screenings for drugs and alcohol and shall submit within seven (7) days. Should any specimen test positive, Ms. Arick shall be suspended indefinitely.

Dr. Glick is currently suspended indefinitely effective immediately. Prior to reinstatement, Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if Dr. is physically/mentally able to return

Dr. shall submit quarterly declarations stating that he has been in compliance with consent, 2) Dr. shall appear for quarterly interviews or as directed, if Dr. leaves Ohio for three (3) continuous months, Dr. must notify Board in writing of dates of departure and return. Dr. shall abstain completely from personal use or possession of drugs, except those prescribed by another so authorized to do so. Dr. shall abstain completely from use of alcohol. Dr. shall participate in aftercare program approved in advance by Board and shall be a minimum of one (1) year. Dr. shall maintain participation in AA or NA, approved in advance by the Board, no less than three (3) days per week. On quarterly basis, Dr. shall submit documentation of continuing compliance with program. Dr. shall participate in Caduceus Program, approved in advance by Board, no less than one day per week. On quarterly basis, Dr. shall submit documentation of continuing compliance with program. Board reserves right to request Dr. to submit random urine screenings for drugs and alcohol and shall submit within seven (7) days. Should any specimen test positive, Dr. shall be suspended indefinitely.
