## CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

Dr. Beacham shall, within six (6) months of the effective date of the consent agreement, successfully complete eighty (80) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning, and restorative dentistry including crown and bridge, at an American Dental Association accredited college of dentistry. Effective date July 21, 2004.

These hours must be pre-approved by the Board Secretary; Ms. Freeman shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam and Ms. Freeman shall appear before the Board upon invitation for the purpose of a reinstatement interview. Upon reinstatement, Ms. Freeman's license shall be subject to probationary terms for a period of three (3) years to commence after serving the suspension. Ms. Freeman shall fully cooperate with the Board investigators in future investigations, inspections and evaluations. Effective date July 21, 2004.

### LABONTE, YVONNE C., R.D.H. (31002838) – Willoughby Hills

Ms. Labonte's dental hygiene license is suspended for ninety (90) days, effective August 1, 2004. The Board shall not consider reinstatement of Ms. Labonte's license until the following requirements are met: Ms. Labonte shall submit a written request for reinstatement to the Board Secretary not earlier than November 1, 2004; Ms. Labonte shall complete six (6) hours of continuing education in Ethics. These hours must be pre-

approved by the Board Secretary; Ms. Labonte shall take and pass the jurisprudence exam and Ms. Labonte shall appear before the Board upon invitation for the purpose of a reinstatement interview. Upon reinstatement, Ms. Labonte's license shall be subject to probationary terms for a period of three (3) years to commence after serving the suspension. Ms. Labonte shall fully cooperate with the Board investigators in future investigations, inspections and evaluations. Effective date July 21, 2004.

**STROEBEL, ANDREW J., D.D.S. (30016500) – Willoughby**

Dr. Strobel's license is suspended for thirty (30) days, effective August 1, 2004. Dr. Strobel shall successfully complete forty (40) hours of continuing education in Pharmacology and proper prescribing. These hours must be pre-approved by the Board Secretary. Dr. Strobel's license shall be subject to probationary terms for a period of five (5) years to commence after Dr. Strobel has served the suspension. Dr. Strobel shall fully cooperate with the Board in future inspections and evaluations and shall make any or all of his patient records available for inspection and review. Effective date July 21, 2004.

**YOUNT, JAMES J., D.D.S. (30021208) – Xenia**

Dr. Yount's dental license is currently suspended indefinitely effective immediately. Prior to reinstatement, the Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if Dr. Yount is physically/mentally able to return to the practice of dentistry.
