

FORMAL ACTION REPORT

Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the Ohio State Dental Board in June 2004.

CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS:

PERRY, R. THOMAS, D.D.S. (30015032) – Dayton

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to meet the standard of care. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 3, 2004.

WOITH, HARRY P., D.D.S. (30016516) – Pickerington

Based on the doctor's alleged failure to administer drugs/prescriptions for other than legal and legitimate therapeutic purpose. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed June 3, 2004.

FINAL ADJUDICATION ORDERS:

STICKLE, MELVIN E., D.D.S. (30010901) – Canton

Dental license is suspended for three (3) months, based on the Board finding Counts 1 through 5 of the Notice of Opportunity to be true, involving failure to comply with infection control rules. Once reinstated, Dr. Stickle's license shall be subject to probationary terms for one (1) year. Dr. Haag shall obtain seven (7) hours of continuing education in infection control, pre-approved in advance by the Board Secretary and shall submit documentation prior to the completion of his suspension. Dr. Stickle shall submit on a quarterly basis documentation that he is in compliance with all infection control rules. Dr. Stickle shall obey all laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Dr. Stickle shall cooperate with the Board inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office. Dr. Stickle shall, at the request of the Board, appear before the Board to discuss his compliance with any infection control requirement set forth in the ORC and OAC. Order sent

June 4, 2004 and will become effective thirty (30) days from the date of mailing this Order. Respondent has 15 days from date of mailing to file an appeal.

CONSENT AGREEMENTS:

BECKMAN, DAVID R., D.D.S. (30018940) – Parma Heights

Dr. Beckman is currently on probation through a Consent Agreement approved by the Board September 10, 2003 for a period of five (5) years with additional terms and conditions. On or about February 18, 2004, Dr. Beckman pled guilty to and was found guilty of possession of drugs in violation of Ohio Revised Code 2925.11, a fourth degree felony, deception to obtain dangerous drugs in violation of Ohio Revised Code 2925.22, a fifth-degree felony and illegal processing of drug documents in violation of Ohio Revised Code 2925.22, a fifth-degree felony. Dr. Beckman's license is hereby suspended for a period of five (5) years. The suspension is stayed on the condition that Dr. Beckman complies with the terms and conditions of the September 10, 2003 Consent Agreement. Dr. Beckman specifically agrees that if he violates the terms and conditions of his current Consent Agreement his license to practice dentistry shall be immediately suspended for a period of five (5) years. Effective date June 4, 2004.

LEBOEUF, MARTIN G., D.D.S. (30011038) – Dayton

Dr. Leboeuf agrees that he will automatically be audited for the next three (3) biennial renewal periods. Dr. Leboeuf shall provide a minimum of two hundred and eighty (280) hours of pro bono dental services to underserved populations, to be completed within one (1) year beginning June 4, 2004. Dr. Leboeuf agrees that he will obey all laws and rules governing the practice of dentistry in Ohio. Effective date is June 2, 2004.

MCGEE, FELICIA J., R.D.H. (31010014) – Cleveland Hts.

Ms. McGee agrees that she will automatically be audited for the next three (3) biennial renewal periods. Ms. McGee agrees that she will obtain a hepatitis titer test and submit documentation of same to the Board within three (3) months. Ms. McGee shall provide a minimum of one hundred (100) hours of pro bono dental hygiene services to underserved populations, to be completed within one (1) year beginning June 4, 2004. Ms. McGee agrees that she will obey all laws and rules governing the practice of dental hygiene in Ohio. Effective date is June 2, 2004.

STRAYER, VANESSA J., R.D.H. (31005139) – Elida

Ms. Strayer's dental hygiene license is currently suspended indefinitely effective immediately. Prior to reinstatement, the Board shall review documentation submitted to determine if Ms. Strayer is physically/mentally able to return to the practice of dental hygiene. Upon reinstatement, Ms. Strayer shall be subject to probationary terms for five (5) years. Effective date June 4, 2004.

SIMMS, BARRY W., D.D.S. (30020551) – Elizabethtown, KY

Dr. Simms is currently licensed in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Pursuant to a consent agreement, Dr. Simms is on probation in Kentucky for a period of five (5) years beginning September 14, 2002 for violating Section 313.130(5) of the Kentucky Revised Statutes involving addiction to a drug habit. Should Dr. Simms practice dentistry in Ohio, the probationary terms of this Consent Agreement shall be in effect. Dr. Simms agrees that should he violate the terms of his probation with the Kentucky Board of Dentistry, his Ohio dental license shall be automatically suspended indefinitely. Effective date June 4, 2004.

WARNOCK, ERIC W., D.D.S. (30014509) – Maumee

Dr. Warnock shall within four (4) months of the effective of this Consent Agreement successfully complete fifty (50) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning,

restorative dentistry, including crown and bridge and endodontics at an ADA accredited dental college. Dr. Warnock shall immediately cease and desist from rendering endodontic treatment. Dr. Warnock shall refer all current patients to other practitioner(s) for endodontic treatment. Dr. Warnock shall not undertake any new cases of endodontic treatment until he has submitted documentation that he has completed the continuing education reference above. After the Board Secretary has informed Dr. Warnock that he may resume providing endodontic treatment, his practice is limited to endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only. Dr. Warnock shall desist from rendering endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth unless he completes additional continuing education. Dr. Warnock shall be subject to probationary terms for a period of one (1) year following notification that he may resume providing endodontic treatment on anterior teeth with single canals only. Dr. Warnock shall submit by the seventh (7) days of each month, documentation for each patient to whom he provided endodontic treatment during the preceding month. Dr. Warnock shall cooperate with the Board's inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office. After complying with the consent agreement for one (1) year, Dr. Warnock may seek approval to perform endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth subject to completion of additional continuing education designated and pre-approved by the Board Secretary. After completing such continuing education and being notified that he may resume providing endodontic treatment on posterior and/or multiple canal teeth, Dr. Warnock shall be subject to probationary terms for a period of one (1) year following such notification. Dr. Warnock shall submit by the seventh (7) day of each month, documentation for each patient to whom he provided endodontic treatment during the preceding month. Effective date June 4, 2004.

YERIAN, MICHAEL A., D.D.S. (30015373) – Springfield

Dr. Yerian shall within three (3) months of the effective date of this Consent Agreement complete thirty (30) hours of continuing education in diagnosis and treatment planning; performance of baseline periodontal evaluations, and restorative dentistry at an

ADA accredited dental college. Dr. Yerian shall be subject to probationary terms for a period of two (2) years. Dr. Yerian shall cooperate in the Board's inspections and/or evaluations of his dental office and shall obey all laws/rules governing the practice of dentistry. Effective date June 4, 2004.

Doctor's request for reinstatement granted by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by the June 2004 Consent Agreement. Reinstatement effective June 4, 2004.

Dental Hygienist's request for reinstatement granted by the Board, subject to probationary conditions established by the June 2004 Consent Agreement. Reinstatement effective June 4, 2004.
